- A vibrant work ordered day where members and staff work together in partnership in the operation of the clubhouse
- A strong employment program that offers three tiers of job placement and support
- An active social component that helps connect members with each other and to social opportunities and connections in the larger community

VIABILITY clubhouses provide members with the opportunity to:

- Increase social, vocational, and educational skills
- Transition into the workplace
- Get back to school
- Increase participation in the community

WORK UNITS

Members have access to several specialized units to manage each club's work as well as to learn and master critical vocational skills. This approach ensures cooperation, inclusion, and shared responsibility. It also allows each member to be productive despite his or her disability.
